2. The tender period shall be **fourteen (14) days** from **6<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 to 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2026**.
3. Tenders shall be quoted in **US DOLLARS** and shall include **all applicable taxes and levies**.
4. Tenders shall remain valid for a period of **One Hundred and Fifty-Six (156) days** from the date of tender opening.
5. All tenders must be accompanied by a **Tender Security from established bank** equivalent to **one percent (1%)** of the tender sum.
6. Prices quoted shall be **fixed for the entire contract period**.

Completed bidding documents must be deposited in the **Tender Box** at the **Embassy of the Republic of Kenya in Bujumbura, Burundi located at** (No. 52 Avenue des Travailleurs, Off Chaussee du Prince Louis Rwagasore) on Monday to Friday (except public holidays) from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.) **on or before Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 at 12.00 noon, (Central African Time)**. Tenders will be opened immediately thereafter in the presence of tenderers or their duly authorized representatives who choose to attend.
10. **Late tenders shall be rejected.**
11. **Electronic tenders will not be permitted.**
12. Tender evaluation and qualification criteria shall be in accordance with the requirements specified in the tender document and the **Kenya Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015** and its attendant Regulations.
13. The Embassy of the Republic of Kenya in Bujumbura, Burundi reserves the right to accept or reject any tender and is not bound to award the tender to the lowest evaluated bidder.
